

Club Night Activities

WHAT TO BRING:

A Bible, Awana Handbook, Awana Uniform (Shirt or Vest) if applicable, and tennis shoes are required each club night. We encourage clubbers to bring a friend; bringing a friend is required for completion of some handbooks (see bring a friend memo for more information regarding this requirement).

DRESS CODE:

Appropriate attire for Awana clubs includes the club uniform(once earned) and soft-soled, closed-toed shoes. Clubbers who do not have appropriate shoes may have to sit out during some of the games played during game time. Keep in mind that children run, jump, and occasionally fall during game time, so long pants are preferred but not required. Please refrain from wearing hats, mid-drift shirts, mini-skirts, or shorty-shorts. All clothing should be church appropriate.

DUES:

Dues are collected to help defray the cost associated with running our Awana program. Dues are \$25 per clubber per year. If paying by check, please make the check payable to *Orchard Crest Baptist Church*. We kindly request that payments be made by your clubber's 2nd night of club attendance. No child will be turned away from Awana because of non-payment. If you are facing a financial hardship that would make your child's participation a difficulty, please ask the Awana Commander, the Awana secretary, or your child's club leader about our scholarship program.

REPLACEMENT HANDBOOKS:

Every clubber is provided an Awana handbook. Handbooks must be brought to club each night, or your clubber may fall behind. Due to copyright laws we are unable to make copies of handbooks for clubbers who lose, forget, or damage their books. If your clubber loses his/her book or it is damaged beyond use, a replacement book can be ordered for them. The cost of a replacement book is \$10.

CHECK IN:

Each clubber must be properly signed in and signed out each week by a parent or other adult designated by the parent. Sign in and sign out will occur in the fellowship hall foyer. Please **DO NOT** drop clubbers off in the parking area. ALL clubbers must be signed in by an adult upon arrival and will only be released to a parent or authorized adult as designated on the Awana release form. No clubber will be released to an underage sibling or friend.

START TIME:

Check in begins at 5:45 PM. A light meal will be served at 6:00 PM and club begins promptly at 6:30 PM.

PICK UP TIME:

Club ends promptly at 8:00 PM. No leaders will be available after 8:30 PM to supervise children. It is imperative that arrangements are made to have your children picked up in a timely manner.

CALENDAR/INCLEMENT WEATHER:

Our Awana club follows the Willard R-2 School calendar. There will be no Awana on any Wednesday night that Willard Schools are not in session; this includes school breaks, holidays, and inclement weather. Awana will also be cancelled if Willard Schools release early on a Wednesday due to inclement weather. Notifications of any other cancellation will be sent out via phone, email, or on Facebook.
